

AP CALCULUS – SUMMER ASSIGNMENT – Alternative for those without MathXL accounts

This year half of the AP Calculus Summer Assignment will be on MathXL. If you do not have access to MathXL because you are a new student or you were not in a class using MathXL last year, you will have to do this part of the summer assignment the old fashioned way – paper and pencil. *If you have a MathXL account, this is not for you.* This alternative is ONLY for students who do not have a MathXL account.

Included on this webpage are two documents titled “For those without MathXL (Part 1 and 2).” This will allow you to download and print the five MathXL assignments. You will turn in your assignments by uploading them to Google Classroom:

- First you must join the class at <https://classroom.google.com>.
- To join, click on the “+” sign and select “Join class.”
- The class code is 58d3kd.
- On our class page you will see a folder into which you will upload your completed assignments.

Part 1 is due on June 30, and Part 2 is due on July 31. There is a penalty for late submission, so please take note of these due dates.

Don’t forget, only half of your summer assignment is from MathXL. There are worksheets posted on the school’s Calculus AB webpage (ap.milfordschools.org). Download the worksheets and be prepared to turn these in ON THE FIRST DAY of class in August. Note: The sections listed on the worksheets correspond to our textbook, so they do not necessarily correspond to the sections listed on your MathXL assignment.

Unfortunately, you will not have access to the online help that MathXL offers. Luckily there are numerous websites that you can refer to for help, such as khanacademy.org, ixl.com, coolmath.com, and of course google.com!
